We extend our gratitude to everyone who volunteered, donated, and supported Operation Cratchit this year. A total of 775 households received Christmas baskets, representing over 3,500 individuals. Over 1,600 children ages birth to 15 years received one new toy or gift. Receiving holiday assistance allowed our neighbors to prioritize their limited resources for necessities. Your efforts truly brightened the holidays for people in need. We are grateful for your contributions.

Because vaccination rates remain low in our community, we continue to host regular vaccine and testing clinics. Thanks to a partnership with **Councilmember Jeff Harris, Gardenland Northgate Neighborhood Association, Pro Youth & Families, Youth and Family Collective, and Sacramento County Department of Public Health**, these clinics provide vaccines & boosters as well as testing.

In addition, we've joined the Sacramento COVID-19 Collaborative (**Sac Collab**), a partnership with Sacramento County Public Health, The Center at Sierra Health Foundation, and a host of community-based organizations. Its mission is to address the conditions that affect the health, well-being, and quality of life of under resourced communities for an equitable and healthier Sacramento. Our Vaccine Ambassadors, Lupita Avalos and Taylor Jordan, provide outreach and support to address vaccine hesitancy and access to vaccines and testing.

We extend a warm welcome to Mai Cheng Lee, our new Executive Assistant. A recent graduate from CSU, Sacramento, she joined our staff group in December, right in the middle of the busiest time of the year. We are glad to have her on board!

Finally, please save two upcoming dates. **Big Day of Giving**, the annual, day-long celebration of giving to local causes, will take place on **May 5, 2022**. And we plan to hold our annual golf tournament, **Fore Good**, on Wednesday, **June 22, 2022**. Stay tuned for more details about both events.

COVID-19 and Health

Increasing COVID-19 vaccinations and centering on equity requires making vaccinations easily accessible, meeting people where they are with information from trusted sources, and eliminating barriers to getting the vaccine. Stanford Settlement Neighborhood Center is proud to be a trusted community partner that provides vaccines and testing on a weekly basis.

The clinics offer all three vaccines – Pfizer, Moderna, and J&J – for first doses, second doses, and boosters. In addition, nurses and vaccine ambassadors are available to talk about the vaccines and address any concerns that our neighbors may have.

The health and safety of our community also depends on having reliable access to testing to reduce the spread of COVID. We hope to continue to provide both rapid testing and PCR testing at our clinics.

Our vaccine ambassadors' outreach has made a huge difference in the vaccination rates in the zip codes around us. In addition to going door-to-door to individuals and businesses, they spread the word at community events and local businesses. They have helped individuals navigate online systems to retrieve their vaccine records, no simple task if they lack a valid photo ID and/or an email address. We are very proud of the concrete actions they take every day to address health equity in our neighborhood!
