Everyone received a box of non-perishable food items, a small gift card to a local grocery store, and one new gift for each child. In total, we helped over 3,400 individuals, and 1,700 children received a present. Thank you for helping make the holidays brighter, especially at the end of a very challenging year for us all.

While we continue to deliver groceries and meals daily to our children, teens, seniors, and families, we are also looking ahead to the time when people can return here for in-person programs. We are feeling more hopeful every day as more vaccine becomes available, and more groups of people are able to get vaccinated. 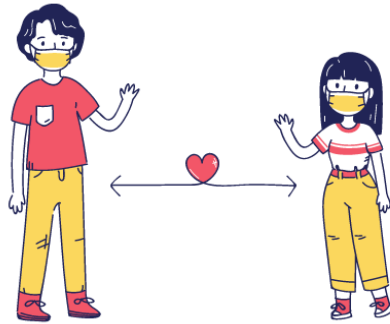
SENIOR CENTER

The Senior Center continues to provide services to the seniors in an alternate manner that will not place our participants at risk. We continue to provide socialization, and nutrition services, including home visits, phone contact, transportation, case management, and more.

TEEN CENTER

The goal of the Teen Center is to keep teens in school and out of trouble. We maintain daily contact through the delivery of meals and virtual activities.

CHILDREN'S PROGRAM



We maintain frequent and regular contact with participants and their families, through outreach and home visits. We share existing resources with families. In addition to lunch deliveries, groceries are available to families as needed.

EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE

On a monthly basis, we will continue to assist families and individuals who are in need with our Grocery Drive-Thru Giveaway. Many who benefit from this receive a bag full of non-perishable foods along with masks to help them navigate through these challenging times.
