Because you shared your time and your treasure, we were able to serve 750 households this year. Everyone received a box of non-perishable food items, a small gift card to a local grocery store, and one new gift for each child. In total, we helped over 3,400 individuals, and 1,700 children received a present. Thank you for helping make the holidays brighter, especially at the end of a very challenging year for us all.

While we continue to deliver groceries and meals daily to our children, teens, seniors, and families, we are also looking ahead to the time when people can return here for in-person programs. We are feeling more hopeful every day as more vaccine becomes available, and more groups of people are able to get vaccinated. SENIOR CENTER


The Senior Center
