Dear Friends,

It's hard to believe that it's been over six months since we closed all of our center-based programs and transitioned to an outward-facing, home visiting approach. Until we are able to re-open, our staff are out in the community daily, delivering meals, groceries, and hope.

We tried something new in September: a drive-thru mask and grocery giveaway! A total of 165 households received assistance, representing almost 700 individuals in need in our community. Special thanks to everyone who donated food, and our volunteers who assisted in loading groceries into cars and handing out masks.

We'll continue this effort monthly, culminating with Christmas baskets in December. We will be accepting donations of non-perishable food items, masks, and paper bags on an ongoing basis.

Our Online Oktoberfest and Virtual Silent Auction is set for October 1-10, 2020. Live events will take place daily at 7 pm online.
